

Permission for Early Release from School

Eligibility:	 Early release is a privilege granted to a junior or senior who: Has earned sufficient credits to qualify as a junior or senior Is in good academic standing Is not under any disciplinary actions Has a legitimate reason for early release 	
Purpose:	Is to allow students to leave campus after their last class of the day for either after school employment or college level classes.	
Steps Needed:	 Early release may be granted when the following steps have been completed by the student: A form signed and dated by the parent and student Interview with the principal over the program's rationale and the responsibilities of the students in this program 	
Dismissal Procedure: • Student must sign him/herself out at the time of departure • Student must leave campus immediately • Student must NOT return to campus during school hours		
 Early Release privilege is revoked immediately if: The student leaves campus during lunch without specific administrative AND parent permission The student signs out but does not leave campus The student signs out, leaves, and returns during normal school hours without the specific permission of school administration The student has more than one "D" or ANY "F" in any class as determined by regular grade checkups by school administration
