Please be aware that "Snow Days" are automatic "Remote Days," and are Half Days. All grades, will meet virtually whenever weather prevents safe travel to school and a snow day is called. If a delayed start is called, then Preschool and PreK students will have no school.

Teachers will be in contact with you regarding the details of blizzard packs, and virtual meeting times and links when a snow day is called.




