


Looking Forward

NOTES

- 1. ONLY PARENTS WITH A FACTS FINANCES ACCOUNT CAN PLACE AN ORDER
- 2. All orders will be placed ONLINE from the PARENT PORTAL
- 3. All orders must be paid at the time of purchase for it to be complete
- 4. Orders cannot be charged to the school account
 - 5. Orders can be placed as early as Friday for the upcoming week, and only one week at a time. They may be placed as late as 9 a.m. the day of the meal. After 9 a.m. the system will shut down and will not take any more orders
 - 6. Meals will be credited ONLY if a child is sick or the school closes unexpectedly for the day. You must report to the office by 9 a.m. that your child is absent and you need a meal credit (parents please mention if your child was signed up for a meal that day as we do not always connect reporting a child absent for illness with the cancelation of the meal.)

HOW TO CREATE AN ORDER:

- Login to www.factsmgt.com, click on PARENT LOGIN, FACTS FAMILY PORTAL District Code: SL-MA; and your login information (username and password)
- When in Parent Portal click on the STUDENT drop down
- 3. Click on LUNCH
- 4. Click on the CALENDAR DAY to choose the day you want to order the lunch (remember just one week at a the time is available)
- 5. Then click on CREATE A WEB ORDER on top of the page. The weekly lunches will appear
- 6. Click on the CHILD'S NAME you want to place the order for
- 7. Choose LUNCH and QUANTITY (each student must have their own order)
- 8. Click on the child's name to choose another sibling if applicable
- 9. When done click SUBMIT ORDER at the bottom

- 10. CONFIRM ORDER AND PAY
- 11. Choose PAYMENT METHOD
- 12. Click PAY AMOUNT NOW
- 13. You should now see the message "THANK YOU. YOUR PAYMENT OF \$\$ HAS BEEN AUTHORIZED AND SUBMITTED."

Please call Mr. Shelton at extension 100 or Mrs. Argueta at extension 106 if you have any questions. Do NOTwait until the last minute to place your orders, especially the first time, to ensure that you get familiar with the ordering process and no technical difficulties present. The ordering system closes at 9 a.m. the day of the particular meal.




