This Monday - 1st Day of School!

On the first day of school we ask that parents drop their children off at the door of the school, with the exception of grades Preschool, Prekindergarten, and Kindergarten. Parents of students in grades P-K are allowed to walk their children to the classroom.

Drop Off & Pick Up

Elementary Building

Drop Off: Elementary doors open at 7:30am.

Pick Up: Parents, please have your child's pick up numbers **VISIBLY DISPLAYED** when you get in line so the patrols know who to call. If the number is not visible it slows down the entire line.

If you do not have a copy of your child's pick up number, or need more copies, please stop by the elementary office for copies for yourself or anyone who will be picking your child up regularly.

Remember that dismissal begins at 3:15 Monday - Thursday and goes until 3:35, and begins at 12 noon on Friday until 12:20 pm.

Academy Building

Academy doors do not open until 7:30am. Please do not drop your child off before 7:30 or they will remain locked out until then.

Traffic Flow

Remember that there are two lanes of traffic. The right lane is for drop off, and the left is for driving through.

Traffic Safety



DO NOT park across the street...

and walk across the street to get your child, or have him or her cross the street to meet you! This is dangerous for everyone involved, and backs up traffic on the main road.

DRIVE SLOWLY in the left lane...

because cars pull out into the left lane suddenly.

Elementary dismissal ENDS PROMPTLY...

at 3:35 pm Monday - Thursday at 12:20 pm on Fridays

If you're LATE your child WILL GO to Daycare!

Students that have not been picked up by 3:35 pm will be sent to After School Care and charged through FACTS. Please plan accordingly.



If you have to strap your child into a car seat, please park your car and come with your number to pick up your child at the front door. This will help our dismissal line move more quickly.

Dismissal Numbers

All elementary students grades P-6 have dismissal numbers assigned to them. These Dismissal Numbers were mailed out this week, and should arrive before the first day of school. Each envelope has 4 copies of your family's Dismissal Number and a letter from Mrs. Gardner explaining the dismissal procedure.

Each family has one number for all the children in the household. Families keep the same number from year to year, so you will have the same number you had last year, unless you are a new family.

If you need additional copies of your child's Dismissal Number for grandparents or family friends who will be picking up your child on a regular basis, please stop by the elementary office for more copies.



Sick? Stay Home!

If your child is exhibiting illness symptoms PLEASE KEEP HIM/HER HOME.

If your child has a fever/vomiting/diarrhea, he/she cannot return to school until 24 hours have passed without a fever/vomiting/diarrhea (without the aid of medication). Your cooperation helps keep kids and teachers healthy.

We would like to thank all the parents that are complying with the illness guidelines in order to make our campus safe. Please continue to monitor your child if he/she shows signs of illness (runny nose, cough, fever, etc.)

From Gloria Cardoso's Obituary:

"Gloria "Lola" Cardoso, 62, passed peacefully on Monday, July 31, 2023 at Hartford Hospital following a brief illness. She is survived by her siblings, Francisco "Chico" Nogueira Cardoso & wife Maria Antonia Cardoso of Porto, Portugal; and Fatima Piresson & husband Pr. Joseph Piresson, of Vernon, CT; generations of nieces and nephews whom she loved as her own children, Pedro Nuno, Micael, Alexandra, Carina, Veronica, Ambrosee, Joseph II, Great-nephews and great-nieces: Leonardo, Jr., Sofia, Ricardo, and Rita; extended family and many dear friends.

Gloria was born in Penafiel, Portugal, daughter of the late Antonio & Florinda (Ferreira) Cardoso. Upon emigrating to the United States, her family settled in Pittsfield, Massachusetts, where Gloria attended local schools and graduated from Taconic High School, Class of 1978. She achieved her Bachelor of Elementary Education degree from Atlantic Union College in 1984 and began her lifelong career as an educator. Ms. Cardoso was an adored teacher in the Marlborough Middle School for more than thirty years until retiring.

She was a woman of great faith, and devout member and pioneer founder of the Lowell Portuguese Seventh-day Adventist Church, where she served in various capacities, notably as Director of Pathfinders and as church treasurer. Uniform Buyback Program & Uniform Store

SLA now has a Uniform Store with new uniforms at full price, as well as gently used uniforms available for sale at 50% off retail price. Our recent order should be arriving next week, so there will be more in stock by then. We are placing another order soon that will mostly include full zip fleece sweaters for the cooler weather.

SLA is now buying back gently used uniform pieces at 30% of retail cost with logo fee. The monetary value of uniforms that are bought back will be credited to a student's account. Credit will be given for used uniforms that are in good shape, with NO holes, NO stains, NO rips, and that are NOT faded. If parents happen to have new, unused uniform pieces with tags, SLA will buy these back at 100% of retail value including logo fee.

New or used uniform pieces can be brought in to the elementary or high school offices anytime the offices are open.

The elementary or high school administrative assistants will receive your gently used uniforms,

fill out the form (seen on this page) with information about the student, parent, and pieces, as well as the monetary credit the family will receive towards the student account. A copy will be given to the parents for their records, and the original will go to JoAnn, the treasurer, so she can know how much to credit to the student's account.

Because this will be the first year of the Uniform Store, and SLA is still building up inventory, parents may not be able to get the uniforms they need for this year through our store yet. You can see the current inventory HERE




New & Used Uniform Store - Delivery is Here!

Dress Code Reminders

- **Jewelry is not allowed** (no earrings, necklaces, bracelets, etc.)
- Skirts and shorts cannot be more than 3 inches above the back of the knee
- Shirts must be Black, Gray, White, or Purple
- Bottoms must be Black, Navy, or Khaki "uniform bottoms" No cargo pants/shorts.



Fridays are "Crusader Fridays" when students can wear jeans along with either a school polo or any Crusader Gear on top!

Ordering Uniforms

For the TOPS it is recommended that you:

- Buy 3-5 Short Sleeve Polo Shirts (depending on how often you do laundry), and be sure to order at least ONE PURPLE SHIRT for field trips, and special school events.
- Button up shirts and blouses are optional and NOT mandatory for anyone who prefers to wear a fancy shirt or blouse rather than a polo.
- Long sleeved polos are also optional and NOT mandatory. Students are allowed to wear a plain long sleeve shirt (MUST BE SOLID WHITE OR BLACK) under their short sleeve polo on chilly days.
- It is a good idea to order 1 Fleece Zip Up Sweater, or other sweater for wearing inside on cold days as well. This is also optional and NOT mandatory, but most kids like to have a sweater for the cold days.

For the BOTTOMS you can:

- Order however many bottoms you feel your child might need (depending on how often you do laundry).
- All bottoms must be uniform bottoms
- Skirts are optional and NOT mandatory for girls.
- Blazers are also optional and NOT mandatory.

- Even if your church is NOT willing to help, getting this form signed lets SLA know, and financial aid can be adjusted accordingly



SET Funds Scholarship

- For high school students only
- Amount is about \$1900
- Must be a member of a SNEC Church to qualify
- Fill out and return to SLA

Financial Aid Application

- APPLICATION DEADLINE: Sept. 1st
- For any student, grades K-12
- Amount is based on financial need
- \$40 application fee per family per year

The English classroom is still under construction. The desks are in their place, the flag is hanging in the corner, and the floor has been shined. What's still under construction? You might ask. The library!


